Electrical	Jungle Jiggle crew at risk of electrical shocks from faulty electrical equipment Jungle Jiggle crew, children and their parents or carers are at risk of electrical shock if put fingers/objects into exposed sockets	Look out for any defective plugs, sockets or equipment, defective equipment removed from use, PAT testing carried out Refer to venue of any defect plug sockets/light sockets etc.	Remind parents/carers that they remain solely responsible for the children in their care	Jungle Jiggle crew/venue	At all times
